

UAC-CP Job Description: Photographer

The Unidad Académica Campesina-Carmen Pampa (UAC-CP) is a college in rural Bolivia that provides access to higher education for poor, indigenous youth. The UAC-CP, internationally recognized for both its unique approach and ability to address and dissipate root causes of poverty, is partially funded by Carmen Pampa Fund (CPF). A non-profit organization based in St. Paul, Minnesota, CPF generates human and financial resources to assist the growth and development of the UAC-CP.

Both the College and CPF share a vision of economic, environmental, and social justice for the people of Bolivia. In recognition of their vital work, in 2003 the United Nations Subcommittee for the Eradication of Poverty designated the UAC-CP as one of the seven most effective initiatives worldwide.

- Photograph daily life at the UAC-CP in a way that Carmen Pampa Fund can share the mission, spirit, and work of the College with donors and supporters (photographs will be used for newsletters, website, annual report, etc.)
- Schedule photo shoots with UAC-CP students, faculty, staff, and volunteers
- Organize photos online in a way that CPF can access photos
- Travel to students' homes and graduates' places of work
- Respect UAC-CP policies (ie. professional code of conduct, etc.)
- Abide by responsibilities and expectations for UAC-CP volunteers
- Interact with UAC-CP students, faculty, staff, and visitors in a manner that is consistent with the values and mission of the College
